

INSPECTIONS IN CROOK COUNTY

According to Resolution No. 9-2004 Section 2A, "Any small wastewater treatment facility, which must have a permit issued by the WYDEQ and are to be constructed, installed or modified in the unincorporated area of Crook County will be required to obtain and inspection by the County designee." *In Crook County, the Crook County Growth and Development Department (CCG & DD) is the Designee that inspects septic systems.*

Crook County Inspection Flowchart

For Landowners/Homeowners/Installers

While anyone can fill out the forms, they are complicated and it recommended to work with someone who has filled them out before.

Obtain Blank DEQ Permit From: DEQ, CCNRD, the Growth and Development Office or On-line

Complete DEQ form (Do Tests/Design System)

Usually the Installer will have the forms and fill them out for the Landowner, however they may charge extra for this

Submit completed form to DEQ

Approved

Denied

Receive reply from DEQ

Request a Modification

Construction can begin here- yet LEAVE OPEN for inspection

If approved, receive County Application for inspection

System can be somewhat constructed but not closed up. Inspector MUST be able to check all dimensions identified on your permit

Return Application with Fee to Crook County Growth & Development (CC G&D)

If not approved, fix the problem and have re-inspected.

Inspector is on-site for inspection

Contact CC G & D (307-283-1540) to make an appointment for an inspection

If approved: finish construction
